

PENNY WARS

February 12 - 20 DRESS-DOWN DAY FEBRUARY 20 (Bring in penny wars money and dress out of uniform!)

-Earn "points" for your class by putting pennies and paper money in your class collection jar. Money will be collected each morning.

-Take away points from other classes by putting silver money in their collection jars.

-The class with the most "points" (average per student) wins <u>a party</u>. -Half of the money collected will be used to help fund this year's 8th grade trip. Half of the money in each class jar will go toward the future funding of that class's 8th grade trip to Israel.



Example:

1 penny = +1 point 1 nickel = - 5 points 1 dime = -10 points 1 quarter = -25 points 1 dollar = +100 points



If a class has 37 pennies (+37), 5 nickels (-25), 12 dimes (-120), 6 quarters (-150), 6 dollars (+600).....the class total is 342 points.

The key aim is to add points (pennies & paper money) to your class jar and subtract points (silver money) from other classes. Therefore 10 pennies in one team's jar can be wiped out by the addition of a dime by another class.

The winning class will be announced Friday, Feb. 21.
