HERE IS A QUICK GLANCE AT SOME OF THE PROGRAMS:

- **Nursing Assistant Certificate: Program Length: 4-12 weeks**

NAs work under the direction of LPNs or RNs, providing basic care to patients.

- **Licensed Practical Nurse Diploma or Degree: Program Length: 12-15 months**

An LPN license provides a nurse with a functioning license to provide basic nursing care. LPNs work under the direction of registered nurses and doctors.

- **Associate Degree in Nursing: Program Length: 2 years**

A 2-year ADN is the quickest way to become a registered nurse (RN). After completing an accredited program, you can take the NCLEX to earn your RN licensure.

- **Bachelor of Science in Nursing: Program Length: 4 years**

BSNs have the same duties and responsibilities as ADNs. However, BSN nurses may have the opportunity to take on additional responsibilities and move into more advanced positions.
