

FALL/WINTER 2019-2020 GRANTS

Venture Portland awarded \$31,700 to fund 10 Fall/Winter Projects in Portland's neighborhood business districts city wide. This round of grants will leverage an additional \$77,760 in private investment – a 2.5-to-1 match.

Benchmark Grant Awards

Benchmark Grants focus on tactical achievements in one of six strategic areas to build strong, vibrant and financially stable business districts.

Destination Investment Grant Award

Destination Investment Grants provide strategic financial support for significant physical improvements in business districts that enhance the customer/visitor experience, reinforce the district's identity and promote the district as a destination.
