- -Have 10 or fewer unexcused absences and/or tardies, and no truancies.
- -Meet Revere's behavior expectations (not involved in any serious disciplinary incident)

\*\*\* Eligibility requirements were posted in Schoology, announced at school, listed in weekly newsletter. Student eligibility will be checked before registration is finalized and payment processed by PEP. If a registration request is submitted for a student that is determined to be ineligible, PEP will notify the parent/guardian and place the student on a wait list. PEP will review the student's 10 week Spring grades to check academic eligibility. If space permits, eligible students will be added from the wait list. Payment will not be processed for ineligible students\*\*\*

<u>Scholarships:</u> Scholarships are available based on need. If you would like financial assistance, the parent/guardian must email a written request to PEPActivities@gmail.com BEFORE Wednesday, January 25. Please include a copy of the parent/guardian's previous year's tax return with the request. Late requests and incomplete requests will only be reviewed if funds are available.

Behavior Expectations: Students are expected to behave appropriately while on the trip. Students will no be with chaperones while at the park.
