KEEPING DANGEROUS CRIMINALS OUT OF COMMUNITIES



Protects Floridians from disastrous bail "reform" policies.



Petitions the Florida Supreme Court to establish a uniform bond schedule that all state courts must follow.



Limits who is eligible for release prior to first appearance and ensures a judge is the ultimate decision maker when it comes to detention.



Requires a detention hearing be held prior to trial for dangerous crimes.

TOUGHER PENALTIES

Ensures the minimum sentence for all child rapists is life in prison without the possibility of parole and advances reforms to reinstate capital punishment for these crimes.

Makes it a first-degree felony to possess, sell, or manufacture fentanyl and other controlled substances that resemble candy.

Makes those who traffic these substances which target children eligible for a life sentence and imposes a minimum 25-year sentence and a \$1 million penalty.

while crime is spiraling out of control in many other parts of this country, florida is enacting policies that are tough on crime and as a result, florida is at a 50 year crime low.
