RE: Flags at Half-Staff in Honor of President George Herbert Walker Bush

On December 1, 2018, as a mark of respect for the memory of the 41st President of the United States, George Herbert Walker Bush, President Donald J. Trump directed all flags to be lowered to half-staff. Pursuant to this direction, and to honor the life of President George H.W. Bush and his dedicated service to his country, I hereby direct the flags of the United States and the State of Florida to be flown at half-staff at all local and state buildings, installations, and grounds throughout the State of Florida. Pursuant to President Donald J. Trump's Proclamation and 4 U.S. Code § 7(m), the flags of the United States and the State of Florida shall remain at half-staff for thirty days, until sunset on Monday, December 31, 2018.
