ABOUT THE FILM: The Defiant Requiem is an Emmy-nominated documentary that tells the heartbreaking but inspiring story of Jewish prisoners at the Nazi concentration camp Terezín, who learned, memorized, and performed forbidden underground performances of Verdi's Requiem in the basement of one of the barracks, all from a single copy of the score in an incredible act of defiance. The Defiant Requiem Foundation collaborated with Partisan Pictures to produce Defiant Requiem. Conceived by Foundation President and Founder, Murry Sidlin, a distinguished conductor, educator, and artistic innovator, Defiant Requiem was written and directed by Doug Shultz. The Executive Producer is Peter Schnall, founder of Partisan Pictures.
