There were 53 legislative offices visited and we made a difference in letting legislators know our priorities for the institution as well as advocating for more funding for higher education.=

Task Forces

### Housing

- Laundry Machines: Many students have told us that the laundry machines are broken a lot in the dorms. We investigated more about what is currently happening with the regular maintenance of them and have an update that there is a new closeby partner that is going to be fixing machines at a quicker turnaround. Machines should be fixed at a much faster rate now due to the maintenance staff being at a closer distance to SOU.
- Communal Kitchen: While students in the Shasta and McLoughlin dorm have meal plans, we also see the value of students having access to a kitchen. We are currently working with housing to hopefully add communal kitchens in these dormitories since we know it will help students have more options for food.

#### Campus Safety

- Bike Safety: Bike theft is the most commonly reported incident to campus safety. From this, we have now added U-Locks to our SOU Campus Bookstore to make them accessible to students to purchase on campus since this lock is the most proven way to prevent theft. We are working on a project to add U-Locks to be able to be rented out at the Student Recreation Center for an affordable rate for students to be able to borrow throughout the academic year.
- Lights on Campus: We are currently doing an assessment of all current lights on campus that are available at night. From this, we hope to make sure all lights work on campus if they are currently not. Additionally, we want

to purchase motion-sensor lights to cover areas that are common pathways for students that are currently not being lit up at nighttime. This can help improve visibility, safety, and encourage more students to attend events in the evening.

### Food Access

- Expanding fresh produce: We have worked on this by establishing a contract where the SOU Farm will be adding produce to regularly be donated to the food pantry to expand the availability of fresh produce for students to have access to.
