lowa is known as a global insurance hub, largely due to being the home of nearly 200 domestic insurance companies. Iowa's insurance industry offers the most rewarding careers. The insurance industry protects people's livelihoods, builds wealth for the future, supports lowa's diverse economy and gives back generously to communities. There are approximately 50,000 jobs in lowa's insurance industry, with average salaries being over \$42,000 more than non-insurance industry counterparts.

Students will gain knowledge and exposure to the Iowa Insurance Division's responsibilities to protect consumers by effectively and efficiently providing a fair, flexible, and positive regulatory environment. Students chosen for this role will participate in performing our regulatory duties in addition to receiving insurance education course work. These individuals will learn about the Iowa Insurance Division's role in state-based insurance regulation, which includes the supervision of insurance companies, insurance agencies, and insurance agents. In addition to learning about each line of insurance (auto, home, life, health, etc.), the interns will also assist with evaluating insurance company market conduct and consumer complaints for compliance with state insurance regulations.

We offer competitive compensation and telework opportunities. This opportunity is available for students across the state of Iowa. Students will have the opportunity to work remotely on Mondays and Fridays, and will be expected to report to the Des Moines office Tuesday through Thursday.
