

CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS:

Teachers as Artists in Washington and Oregon

GENERAL INFORMATION

Maryhill Museum of Art, working in partnership with Oregon Art Education Association and Washington Art Education Association, wants to showcase TEACHER talent by inviting educators to participate in a juried exhibition in the MJ Murdock Charitable Trust Education Center.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Must be a current member of OAEA or WAEA. Submit up to (2) high-resolution images, titles of each piece, dimensions, and the year each piece was made. Artists whose work is chosen will also submit a brief artist statement (500 word maximum). Selected works must be ready to hang on the wall (matted artwork is required, framed is preferred). Three-dimensional work requiring special display (ie: necklace) must be submitted with the display.

Teachers will be notified via email. Artwork delivery and pick-up is the responsibility of the teacher. Maryhill will do its best to facilitate delivery and pick up.

JURY PROCESS

Jurors are Mike Murawski, Director of Education and Public Programs at Portland Art Museum, and Samantha Kelly, Director of Education at Tacoma Art Museum. Artwork will be anonymous during the jury process. Decisions of the jurors are final.

Washington Teachers: Submissions accepted January 4 to January 28, 2017.

Exhibition: March 15 - April 26, 2017

Oregon Teachers: Submissions accepted August 13 to September 3, 2017

Exhibition: October 6 - November 15, 2017
