TEACHING TIPS WITH TECHNOLOGY



What is examity?

Examity is an online remote proctoring tool for maintaining exam integrity. With examity, instructors can effectively detect and flag suspicious activities by students.

Why use examity?

Instructors should consider using examity to test students in online and in-person courses that do not have the flexibility to test on campus or during regular college hours.

How to begin?

To begin using examity, instructors submit test requests to examity from their course dashboard in Blackboard and set up the exam for students by making it "available." Students have to schedule a test appointment through their course dashboard in Blackboard.

Modalities

Examity offers two proctoring modalities, Automated and Live. The instructor chooses the best option for the exam.

- 1. <u>Automated Proctoring</u>: Auto ID authentication. <u>Automated + Audit:</u> Auto ID authentication and human audit.
- 2. <u>Live Proctoring Premium</u>: Live Proctoring is optimal for high-stakes, high-security exams. It offers the highest possible level of exam security.
 - <u>Live Proctoring Standard:</u> Once live authentication is complete, the exam session activity is monitored by proprietary technology rather than a live proctor.

Things to know:

- Test sessions are recorded in all modalities
- Faculty can choose to review the recorded session after the exam
- Platforms such as WileyPLUS can work with examity.
- Examity and Respondus Lockdown Browser are not the same.
- Examity requires at least 24 hours to process test requests.
- Examity uses Artificial Intelligence (AI) technology in all its testing modalities.
- DSS students with double-time accommodations can use examity for testing if Blackboard settings are adjusted to meet the appropriate time accommodation.

Technical Requirements

- Browser: Google Chrome, please disable your pop-up blocker.
- Equipment:
 - Desktop, laptop, or Chromebook (tablets are not supported)
 - A built-in or external webcam
 - A built-in or external microphone
 - A built-in or external speakers
- Internet: An upload and download speed of 2Mbps.
