#### **Finals & Winter Session Edition**

You have all come so far this semester and the finish line is within sight! We are sending you our best wishes as you take on finals and close out a semester to remember. We write to share information on a few housekeeping items as the semester wraps up.

### **Winter Session Programming**

According to *duLac*, the last day of classes serves as the last day of programming for student groups. Undergraduate student groups can no longer program, effective November 12, 2020. This includes speakers, general meetings and other activities. With the goal of giving you a well-deserved break, student group activity will remain prohibited through Tuesday, January 5, 2021.

Beginning Wednesday, January 6, virtual undergraduate student group programming is permitted to resume (note that SAO360 requests will not resume being processed until Jan. 6).

We are planning for in-person programming and activities for student groups to resume for the spring semester on Wednesday, February 3.

#### **Apparel Orders**

Any pending apparel requests in SAO360 as of Friday, November 20, 2020 will remain pending until Wednesday, January 6, 2021. These requests will begin to be routed on this date, and the Student Activities Office will be able to accept shipments and deliveries beginning Monday, January 25, 2021.

#### **Closing Out Financial Requests**

If there are outstanding unpaid invoices, contracts, or reimbursements, now is the time to complete these transactions. While this process normally concludes at the end of the semester, we have granted an extension until Tuesday, December 15. All outstanding payment requests MUST be submitted by 5 p.m. that day to be completed.
