Encaustic is a paint made of beeswax, resin and pigment. Melted and applied to an absorbent surface, it is then fused (re-melted) to create a variety of effects. An ancient painting tradition, artists are rediscovering the amazingly versatile medium which lends itself to a wide range of creative expression.

Safe studio set up & practices Use of tools & materials (paint, medium, supports) Examples of ancient & contemporary encaustic work Technique demonstrations include paint application and fusing, color mixing, creating texture, scraping/incising, collage & embedding, image transfers, masking & stencils
