



· Dress Code and Cell Phone Policy ·

Members are encouraged to consider common sense, respect for tradition, modesty, and the comfort level of fellow members when making country club dress code decisions. Please inform all guests in advance of the following policies. Proper dress attire is mandatory for all members and guests in all areas of Spring Lake Country Club, as outlined below:

The Clubhouse

Appropriate “country club casual” attire, including nice denim, is permissible in the Clubhouse and on the patio. For gentlemen, country club casual attire consists of tailored slacks, jeans or Bermuda-length shorts, collared or turtleneck shirts, and dress shoes or appropriate footwear. Shirts must be tucked in at all times unless specifically tailored to fit untucked. For ladies and girls suitable attire includes classic, modest, tasteful, and tailored outfits, with dress shoes or appropriate footwear. Golf shorts, skirts and skorts must have a 15” or longer out seam.

Hats may be worn with the bill forward in the Clubhouse everywhere except the Front Nine and Back Nine dining areas.

Children are expected to follow the same dress code with appropriate casual clothing in these areas.

Golf Course & Practice Facilities

Women: Appropriate golf attire, which may include golf slacks, Bermuda-type shorts and golf skirts that have a 15-inch or longer out seam. The following apparel items are not allowed: halter and tank tops, jeans, cut-offs, bathing suits or pool attire, tennis outfits, or fitness center attire such as lycra leggings or sweat/jogging outfits.

Men: Appropriate golf attire, which may include golf slacks, Bermuda-type shorts that are not higher than five-inches above the knee and collared shirts. Shirts must be neatly tucked into slacks or shorts. The following apparel items are not allowed: jeans, cut-offs, baggy shorts, bathing trunks, sweat pants, nylon jogging suits or tennis shorts.

All hats and caps must be worn with bill forward. Golf shoes with metal spikes are not permitted, nor are hard-soled shoes or boots allowed on the golf course.

Private Parties / Business Meetings

Appropriate dress is required. Please refer to the above policies for direction.

Cell Phone Use

The club understands that cell phones have become a way of life for many members and their guests. We respectfully ask that you use good judgment and a sense of etiquette in complying with the club’s cell phone policy. Cell phones are permitted on *vibrate mode only*. If receiving calls, you must excuse yourself from dining areas and the Golf Shop to an unoccupied area, the locker room or parking lot. Use of speaker phone mode is not permitted.

Please ensure that guests and children adhere to this policy as management and fellow members will enforce these rules.
