



Syrah, Sonoma Mountain, 2019

Winemakers Notes:

The Sonoma Mountain region, known for the diverse micro-climates that occur on exposed hillsides and shaded drainages, is what resident Jack London was thinking about in 1913 when he wrote, "The air is wine. The grapes on a score of rolling hills are red with autumn flame. Across Sonoma Mountain, wisps of sea fog are stealing. The afternoon sun smolders in the drowsy sky. I have everything to make me glad I am alive."

Tasting notes:

Smells like chocolate frosting, deeply concentrated red fruit, some hints of pine, lush, rich, velvety, a latte made with a very dark roast, palate is rich and bold, very textural. This is a wine to pair with all your favorite winter foods, Smooth and integrated on the palate.

Fermentation: open top tank, whole cluster fermentation. Will age for 5-7 years.
