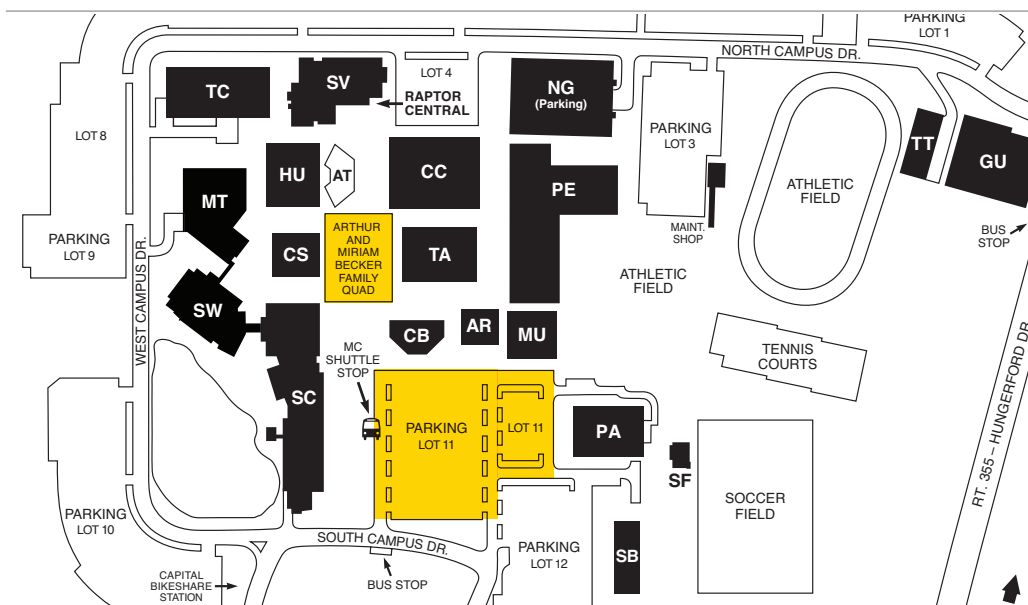

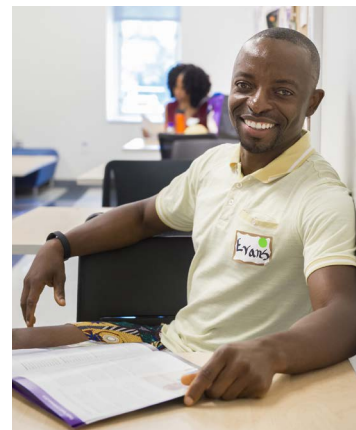
This event educates and connects individuals who care for children of all ages with the resources they need to be successful parents—and help them thrive in Montgomery County.

Functional Training Zone

An educational platform that inspires young adults who are seeking knowledge from active, experienced career professionals through workshops, podcast, and career exploration events, which allow them to make a well-informed and lucrative career.

Gaithersburg Financial Empowerment Center

Provides free one-on-one financial coaching to help residents toward greater financial stability.

Housing Initiative Partnership Inc.

Develops innovative affordable housing, revitalizes neighborhoods, and equips people to achieve their housing and financial goals.

Housing Opportunities Commission (HOC)

Provides affordable housing and supportive services that enhance the lives of low- and moderate-income families and individuals throughout Montgomery County.

HOC's Fatherhood Initiative Program

Open to any father with children living in HOC housing, participating in HOC housing programs, or on the HOC waitlist, regardless of age. The program covers all aspects of being a father, including responsible parenting, healthy relationship education, employment stability, and mobility and case management.

Activities for Children

Independence Now

A nonprofit organization designed, governed, and staffed by people with disabilities. They are part of a nationwide network of Centers for Independent Living, and serve as a resource and advocacy center that promotes independent living and equal access for people of all ages with all types of disabilities residing in Montgomery and Prince George's Counties.

MoCo ReConnect

An initiative of the Montgomery County Collaboration Council for Children, Youth, and Families, Inc., in which partner organizations work together to reconnect youth and young adults to educational, workforce, and community-based services.

Montgomery County Public Schools Prekindergarten/Head Start Program

Offers a high-quality educational experience to income-eligible children to prepare them with the foundational knowledge and skills necessary for school success in kindergarten and beyond.

Montgomery County Recreation Office of Communication and Public Outreach

Provides information for Montgomery County Recreation programs, camps, services, and special events.
